

Analysis: Afghanistan pullout spurs EU to revive rapid reaction force

- Despite 1999 pledge, EU still without deployable forces
- EU wants to be able to act independent of U.S.
- EU defense research has been main focus since 2017

LJUBLJANA, Sept 1 (Reuters) – The chaotic withdrawal of Western forces from Afghanistan has shown that the European Union needs to intervene militarily in a crisis without relying on U.S. troops, senior EU officials say.
