Deutsche Bank settles record \$75 MILLION Epstein sex-trafficking lawsuit: Accusers to receive up to \$5M each after judge ruled he 'solicited bank's advice about structuring withdrawals to evade notice'

Deutsche Bank has agreed to pay \$75 million to settle a proposed class-action lawsuit alleging the German bank facilitated the late Jeffrey Epstein's sextrafficking ring, according to attorneys for the plaintiffs.

The suit was filed last year in New York by a woman listed in court filings as Jane Doe 1 on behalf of herself and other accusers, alleging Deutsche Bank did business with Epstein for five years despite knowing he was engaged in sextrafficking.

Deutsche Bank did not admit wrongdoing as part of the settlement, a person familiar with the matter told DailyMail.com late on Wednesday.

The plaintiffs' lawyers, from the law firms Boies Schiller Flexner and Edwards Pottinger, said they believed the \$75 million settlement was the largest sextrafficking settlement involving a banking institution.
